SOME THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- From Term 2 please bring a piece of fruit to contribute to shared morning tea. This will be cut up and served by our volunteers.
- Please bring your own water bottle and hat for outside play.
- A change of clothes is always recommended, as playgroup gets a little messy sometimes!
- Strict hand washing before food and activities please, including as you enter the building. Hand sanitizer is available at the ELC entrance.
- If you or your child are unwell or vulnerable, please stay home and rest.
- Importantly, playgroup is all about having fun and making friends, for the children and the adults. So please know you are always welcome, even on the days you've had little sleep or are feeling a little low. Playgroup is a great place to meet over coffee with friends and family who love you and are there for you, especially in this busy season of raising babies and toddlers. We're here for you and pray for you often!
