WHAT IS BEING PROPOSED?



The Church Board with endorsement from the School Board are proposing to create a new entity The King's Community Inc.

"To create a new entity (The King's Community Inc.) that would be jointly owned by King's Baptist Church and King's Baptist Grammar School, as the vehicle by which Masterplan 2.0 can be completed."

WHAT IS MASTERPLAN 2.0?



Master plan 2.0 is the outcome of November 12, 2017 church Vote on the proposal 'The King's Baptist Church congregation approves funding to the value of \$7500 for the purposes of seeking professional services for the process of community master planning in partnership with King's Baptist Grammar School'. This master plan responds to the King's Community and wider community's needs and offers provisions for the following:


- Purpose built Auditorium / Performance Space
- Purpose built Café
- Faith based Early Learning Centre (ELC) for 3 & 4 year old children
- Multi-purpose rooms
- Dedicated youth space
- Space for future ministries to develop

What do you mean by 'The King's Community Inc.'?

The King's Community is a new entity that would be created and funded between the church and school via asset contributions:

- The church would contribute its major physical asset (its building) and the school would contribute the community house (once title is obtained and completed) and a cash contribution to make up the same value as the church, or more if required.
- The new entity could then acquire a loan in its own right to help fund the new joint developments (Master Plan 2.0).
- The church and school would thus be partners in joint mission in the operation of the new facility, purpose built to provide for the needs of our neighbourhood.
- The Church and School would effectively become tenants of the new facilities.
- Income streams provided by the "tenants" (primarily the ELC and Cafe), hold significant potential to fund further ministry and mission.

CONCEPTUAL STRUCTURE

Questions and Answers

We have done our best to answer as many questions as we can at this stage. It is important to note that there will be some questions we do not have answers for yet. We have kept this document content focused on the big picture to help us discern if this is what God is calling us to be a part of.

Q. What are the expected disruptions if we go ahead with Master Plan 2.0?

- The ELC will be built first which will disrupt much of the regular activity that happens in the existing church auditorium.
- We have found alternate options for all ministries and groups to continue to gather together and continue ministry programs during the period of disruption. For instance, there are a number of spaces at the school we are currently exploring to hold our Sunday Worship services.

Q. How will the governance of the new entity 'The King's Community Inc' operate?

- As this is a joint project, The King's Community Inc will be jointly governed by both King's Baptist Church and King's Baptist Grammar School.

Q. Has the plan received support from the school and Baptist Churches of SA?

- We have been given in principle agreement by the Church Board, School Board and the Assembly Council of Baptist Churches of SA.

Q. How long would it take to complete the building?

- The goal would be to have: (Subject to council approval)
 - The ELC complete at the beginning of 2019
 - All other spaces to be completed approx. mid-2020.

Early Learning Centre

Q. Why an Early Learning Centre?

- As a response to the community consultation which clearly showed there was a desire from the community that an ELC was needed in the community.
- Over 100 families have registered interest in their child attending the ELC.
- There is a desire to extend the King's care and education on offer to families in the community to include children 3 & 4 years of age.
- There are no other faith based ELC's in the local area.

Q. How will the church engage with ELC and vice versa?

- The ELC will provide a further platform to connect with our community, via families of 3 & 4 year olds.
- Church and ELC engagement will include some formal interactions through a church chaplain to the ELC, playgroups, programs and other family support and care services run by the church and ELC.
- Informal connections such as families using the café.
- It creates a new way to enhance connections with families in the area.

Q. Why is the ELC being built first?

- As a church focused on the community, an ELC has been identified as a highly sought after community need.
- The school has committed to the community and neighbourhood to fulfil this need by 2019. For this to occur, it needs to be the first space created.

Q. Why can't the ELC be built on the Community House land and keep the existing auditorium as multi-purpose space as originally intended?

- Masterplan 1.0 explored the option of keeping the existing auditorium as the new multipurpose space and building the ELC where the community house is. Once completing the master planning process, and receiving feedback from members of the community, it was determined that it was not the best use of the space or the best way to meet the future needs of the community.

Q. What will the faith and values of the ELC be?

- It will be a faith based ELC with an approach inspired by the work of the educators of Reggio Emilia.

Q. Is there a business plan?

- A preliminary business plan has been completed working on a net return of 10%.
- This needs further revision once there is greater clarity on the building work involved.

Purpose Built Commercial Cafe

Q. Why build a new café?

- We have been presented with the opportunity to create a café space that is truly a 'third space' with 7 day trading and equipped to provide a wider offering for the community.

Auditorium/Performance Space

Q. How many people will the new auditorium/performance space hold?

- Master plan 2.0 currently shows the new auditorium at 500m², compared with the existing 350m². This represents 40 - 45% greater capacity.
- Seating capacity will depend on the type of seats provided but we hope to seat around 500 people.

Multi-Purpose Space

Q. How big will the space be?

- Master plan 2.0 shows 560m² for multi-purpose use.
- The existing auditorium which doubles as multi-purpose space along with the seminar room is 435m². The proposed multi-purpose space will be larger.

Q. Where will the storage space be?

- There will be storage facilities in the multi-purpose room.

Q. Will this space be suitable for small group gatherings, small group teaching, prayer meetings and bible studies?

- There will be dividers to create smaller spaces to facilitate these.

Space for Future Ministries

- Allowance has been made for some spaces to be created, without specific ministries being placed in the space, with the desired purpose to allow for growth and for new things to emerge.
 - Eg. Allied health type provisions have been identified as a desire in the community and is an idea the leadership team is exploring.
